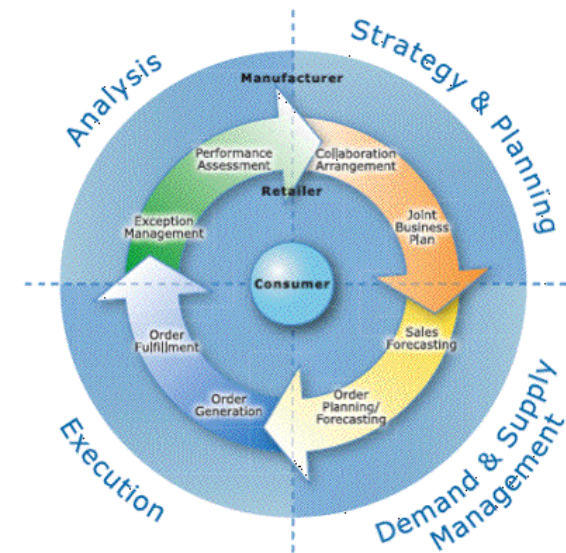

- Results released in 9.3

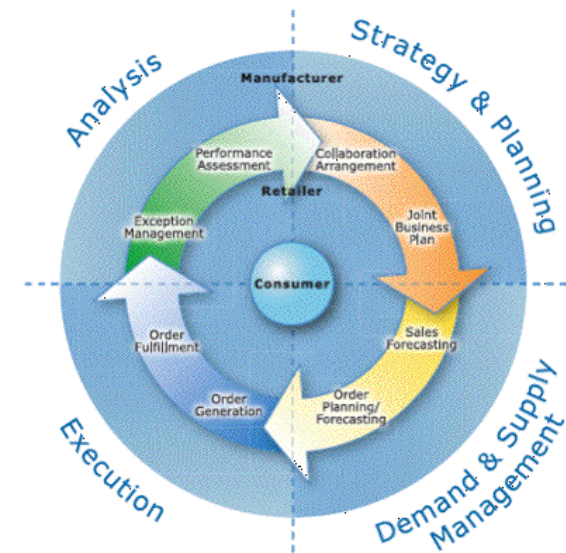
