### **OAGi CEO Speaking at Remittance Advice Standards Workshop on June 28**

David Connelly, our OAGi CEO, will be speaking at the Remittance Advice Standards Workshop hosted by the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis and ASC X-9. Several other standards organizations that have a Remittance Advice will also be speaking, including IFX and GS1.

The Federal Reserve Bank is trying to understand what standards are available and how they are used so they can try to increase the number of online transaction over paper use.

### **OAGi Chemical Council Architect speaks in Japan**

Jim Wilson, our Chemical Industry Council Architect, spoke at the Japan Petrochemical Association (CEDI) Forum in Tokyo on June 7. Jim briefed the record large group of 151 persons on who OAGi is, what we did with the Chem eStandards over the past year, and where the standards are going.

It was also reported that the first cases of trading between a Chemical company and a Tire and Rubber Company through another member company, Elemica.
